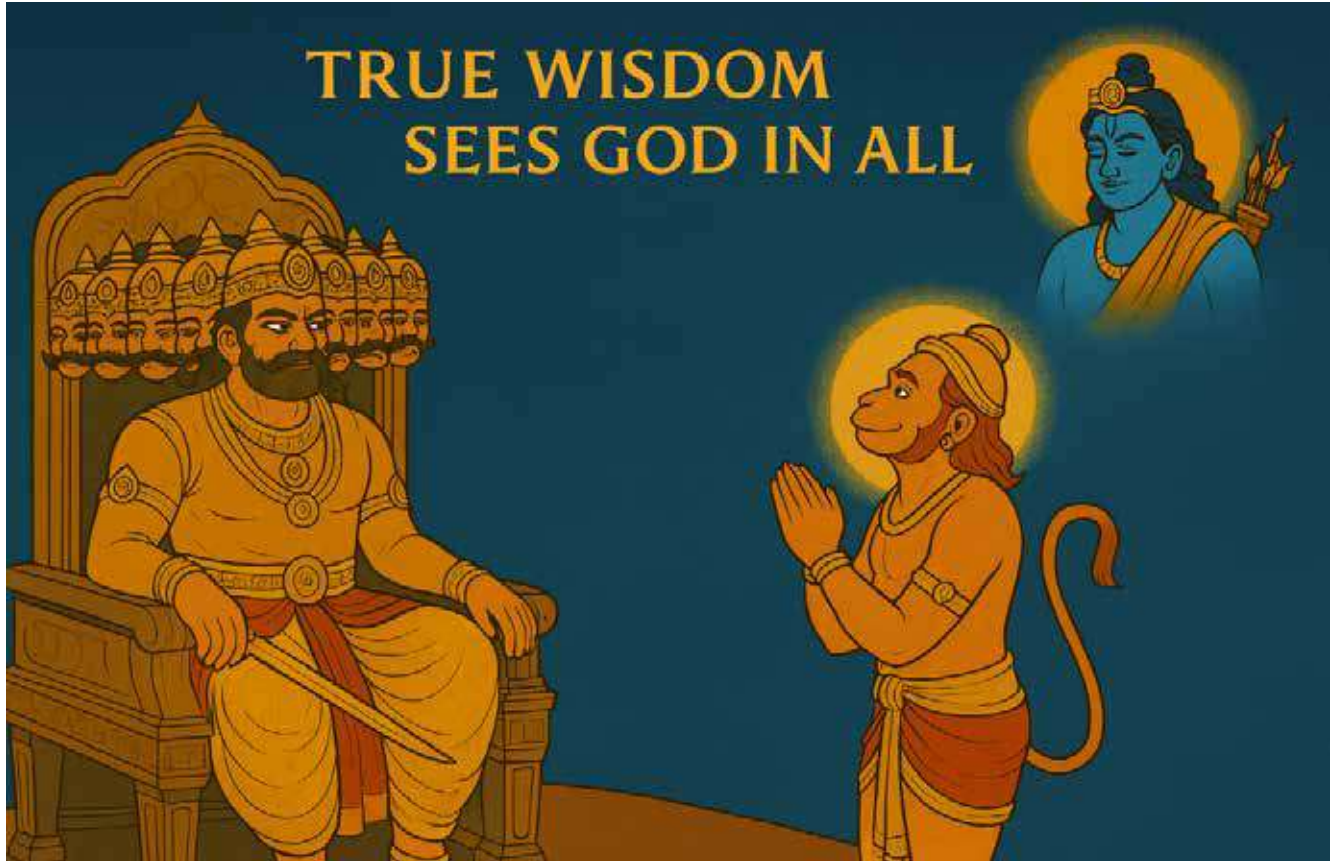

Difference Between Vidvān (Learned) and Vidyāvān (Truly Wise)

India has always been celebrated as the land of profound knowledge — where learning was never limited to books but was deeply connected with values, culture, and spirituality. The Indian Knowledge System (IKS) teaches that the purpose of education is not only to sharpen the mind but also to purify the heart. In our ancient scriptures, two important concepts related to learning are beautifully explained — Vidvān and Vidyāvān.

A Vidvān is someone who gains knowledge but may become arrogant with it, while a Vidyāvān is one who uses knowledge with humility, compassion, and devotion to serve society. This difference is clearly reflected in the characters of Ravana and Lord Hanuman — two great personalities known to every Indian child.

Ravana was Vidvān (intellectually knowledgeable), whereas Lord Hanuman was Vidyāvān (spiritually wise).

**“वदियावान गुनी अतःचातुर।
राम काज करबि को आतुर॥”**

There is a great difference between being Vidvān and Vidyāvān. We can understand this through the example of Ravana and Lord Hanuman. Ravana possessed the knowledge of four Vedas and six Shastras — together symbolizing the ten heads he is depicted with. One who carries these ten scriptures in his intellect is called “Ten-headed” (Dashagriva). Thus, Ravana was indeed a highly learned scholar.

But what was the tragedy? Despite such knowledge, he abducted Mother Sita. Often, learned people, intoxicated by their intellect, snatch

away the peace of others — just as Ravana abducted Sita. Their ego abducts the “Sita-like peace” of others, while Hanuman restores that peace by reuniting it with God.

Hanumanji said:

“वनिती करउँ जोरकिर रावन ।

सुनहु मान तजभोर सखावन ॥”

He folded his hands before Ravana — does that mean Hanuman lacked strength? Absolutely not. People fold their hands either out of fear or out of devotion. Ravana replied proudly that many stand before him with folded hands:

“कर जोरे सुर दसिपि वनिता ।

भृकुटी वलिकत सकल सभीता ॥”

Here lies the difference: Ravana intimidated others into fear-based respect, while Hanuman folded his hands out of humility.

Ravana boasted:

“कीधौ श्रवन सुनेहनिहोही ।

देखउँ अतिसंक सठ तोही ॥”

He said — “Have you not heard of me? You look too fearless!”

Hanuman replied — “Is it necessary that whoever comes before you must come trembling?”

Hanuman pointed out that the gods standing fearfully were looking at Ravana’s eyebrows (his anger). But he said:

I look at Lord Rama’s eyebrows:

“भृकुटी वलास सृष्टालय होई ।

सपनेहु संकट परै कसोई ॥”

Even a slight movement of Lord Rama’s eyebrows can dissolve the universe — yet the one who seeks refuge in Him faces no danger even in dreams.

Ravana asked — If you look at Rama, why fold hands before me?

Hanuman replied — “This is your illusion. I fold these hands only to Him.”

Ravana challenged — “Where is He?”

Hanuman answered with the Lord’s teaching:

“सो अनन्य जाके असमितनि टरइ
हनुमन्त ।

मै सेवक सचराचर रुप स्वामी भगवन्त ॥”

God instructed Hanuman: “See Me in all beings.”

Therefore, Hanuman said — “I see not you, but God dwelling within you.”

“खायउँ फल प्रभु लागी भूखा ।

और सबके देह परम प्रपि स्वामी ॥”

Because of this, Hanuman even addressed Ravana as “Prabhu” and “Swami”. But Ravana...

“मृत्यु नकिट आई खल तोही ।

लागेसि अधम सखावन मोही ॥”

...insulted Hanuman, calling him wicked and lowly.

This is the identity of a Vidyāvān:

One who sees God even in the one who insults him.

A true wise person reflects the principle:

“वदिया ददाति वनियं ।

वनियातयाति पात्रताम् ॥”

Education should bring humility.

One who becomes arrogant is merely Vidvān;

One who becomes humble is Vidyāvān.

Tulsidasji says:

“बरसहजिलद भूमनियिराये ।

जथा नवहविध वदिया पाये ॥”

Clouds full of water descend lower;

just as the truly knowledgeable become more humble.

Hanuman — humble = Vidyāvān

Ravana — proud = Vidvān

Who is Vidvān?

One whose intellect has grown, but whose heart has become corrupted by ego.

Who is Vidyāvān?

One whose heart is filled with God,

and who inspires others to bring God into their hearts.

Hanumanji advised Ravana:

“राम चरन पंकज उर धरहु ।

लंका अचल राज तुम करहु ॥”

“Place the lotus feet of Lord Rama in your heart — and then rule Lanka fearlessly and blissfully.”

Lesson:

In life, gaining knowledge from books, school, and technology is important — but what truly shapes a great person is how that knowledge is used.

Ravana knew all the scriptures, yet his ego led him toward destruction.

Hanuman, on the other hand, used his knowledge with devotion, humility, and service — and became a symbol of true wisdom and greatness.

- Vidvān → A person who is knowledgeable but may become proud
- Vidyāvān → A person who is not only knowledgeable but also kind, respectful, humble, and helpful

For students today:

- Grades are good — but goodness is greater
- Intelligence is valuable — but character is priceless
- Success becomes meaningful only when others benefit from it
- Real education teaches us to see the good in everyone
- 1. So aim high — but stay grounded
- 2. Learn more — but live with love
- 3. Be successful — but also be compassionate
- **Don’t strive to be only Vidvān (scholarly).**
- **Strive to be Vidyāvān (wise and humble).**

You are the future — let your knowledge bring light, respect, and happiness into the world.

Cybersecurity for Everyone: Are We Truly Safe Online?

Every click we make online leaves behind a digital trace. From banking and shopping to social media and education, our lives have become deeply connected to the internet. While this has made life easier, it has also opened the door to an alarming rise in cybercrime. In India, incidents such as UPI frauds, phishing attacks, and fake apps are becoming increasingly common. This raises an important question: are we truly safe online?

Many people believe that cybercriminals only target large organizations or government departments. The reality is quite different. Ordinary individuals are often the easiest victims. Hackers exploit our everyday mistakes—weak passwords, ignoring software updates, clicking on suspicious links, or oversharing on social media. Just one wrong move can lead to loss of money or sensitive personal information.

The statistics are worrying. India now

ranks among the top five most cyber-attacked countries in the world. Fraudsters use fake websites and mobile applications that look exactly like genuine ones. Unsuspecting users, in a hurry, often share their banking details or login credentials without verifying the authenticity of the platform. While digital payments and online services have made life convenient, they have also provided cybercriminals with more opportunities.

5 Ways to Stay Safe Online

- ▶ Use strong and unique passwords for every account.
- ▶ Enable two-factor authentication (2FA) wherever possible for added protection.
- ▶ Pause and think before clicking on links in emails, WhatsApp messages, or unknown websites.
- ▶ Update software and apps regularly to fix security flaws.
- ▶ Avoid using public Wi-Fi for banking and sensitive transactions.

Using the same password for multiple accounts is one of the biggest risks. If hackers manage to access one account, they can easily break into all other accounts with the same password. This makes it crucial to set unique passwords everywhere.

While technology can help secure our devices, the biggest defense against cybercrime is awareness. Schools, colleges, and workplaces must conduct regular training programs

on cybersecurity. Knowing how to identify fake websites, phishing messages, and suspicious downloads can prevent serious financial and emotional harm.

As technology advances, cybercriminals are also becoming more sophisticated. With the growth of Artificial Intelligence (AI), the Internet of Things (IoT), and 5G connectivity, the nature of cyberattacks will continue to evolve.

But the first line of defense is not software or antivirus programs—it is us. By being cautious and adopting safe online practices, we can protect ourselves and those around us.

The digital world has transformed our lives, but it must be navigated with care. Cybersecurity is no longer just an IT problem; it is everyone's responsibility. The question is not whether hackers will try, but whether we are prepared to stop them.
