Use of Deepfake- A Threat to Democratic Elections

After 2017 deepfakes i.e. synthetic audio-visual media of human faces, bodies or voices, often created using artificial intelligence went mainstream. While the use of deepfakes for fake porn skyrocketed, mundane and prosocial uses increased significantly, so did the technology's political applications. The debates in the public focus on this malicious political potential. Policy analysts are afraid of deepfakes' challenge to truth in politics human rights organizations that the technology may be abused by authoritarian regimes and even journalists see democracy threatened in general. Deepfakes are merely a new tool for manipulating media, and this tool is continuously evolving within the information landscape, where the proliferation of disinformation is a critical concern, particularly in social media. The increasing quality and persuasiveness of deepfakes only exacerbate the familiar issues posed by manipulated media. Until recently, achieving such quality was nearly impossible, which meant that audio and video enjoyed a simple advantage in terms of credibility due to their convincing nature. As audio and video have a primal appeal to people, surpassing the impact of text or photo, the challenges posed by manipulated media become even more pronounced.

False narratives can be created and boosted using deepfakes, giving a virtual speech or statement can be generated. All these fakes can mislead voters, confuse public discussion, and lose trust in electoral organizations. Truly convincing videos or recordings, which turn out to be 100% fake after a pause, can fundamentally change the perception of political candidates, parties, or issues as a whole. Unquestionably, this may affect people's voting behavior, motives, and preferences, the total number of votes, and eventually, the outcome of the vote and the principle of democracy. The progressive distribution of deepfake technology can jeopardize democracy if it causes any difficulty

that some recorded materials spread by candidates on the street or in various mass media may not be genuine. This problem creates openness and suspends the runners. An endless descent into unbelief never benefits the election quality.

Shortly before the critical elections in Pakistan, the country's strongest and most popular politician felt needed to mobilize his supporters. However, he had a big problem – he was in prison. Therefore the team of Imran Khan generated an AI version of him to appeal to the Pakistanis to come out and vote. This version of Khan said if you come out in big enough numbers there is no one who can stop him and he was right. Khan's party unexpectedly received an impressive number of votes, and his team acknowledged that part of the voters were indeed inspired by his AI version.

This case is not unique: the AI in election campaigns has already reached the Asian countries. In Indonesia, a party organized a video in which the deceased military ruler Suharto urged the people of Indonesia to vote for the presidential candidate Prabowo Subianto – his ex-son-in-law. This year, in March, Subianto was actually elected as Indonesia's new president. Such videos are quite simple to produce today, requiring only a few minutes of speaking and an existing photo and sound. Some critics even called this technology "cheap fakes," but it is essential to address what extent the availability of such technologies can complicate the election process in regions with low digital intelligence and a high level of disinformation.

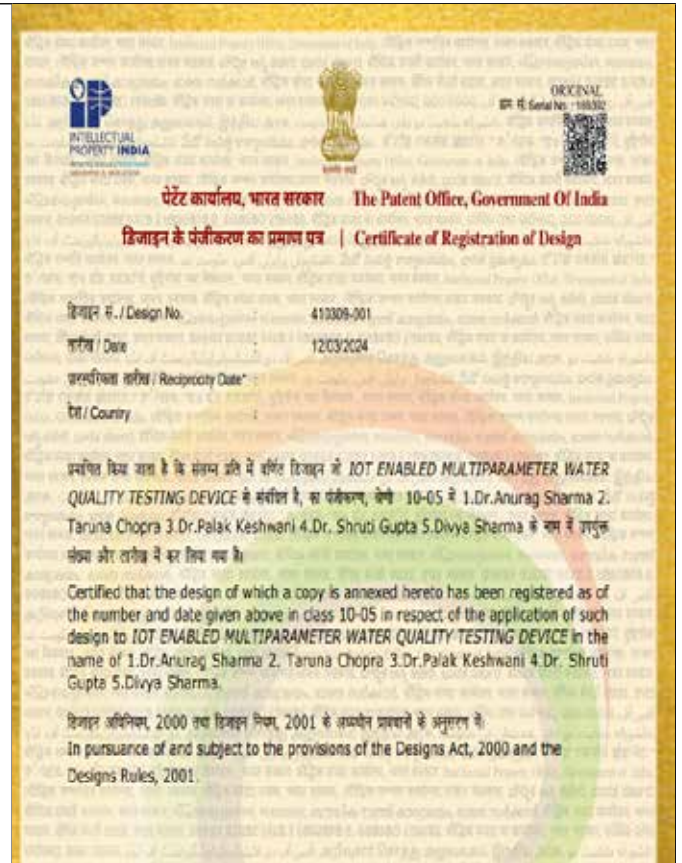

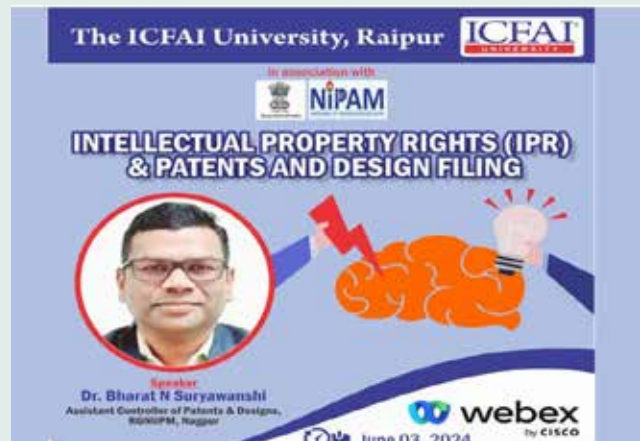
University Activities
